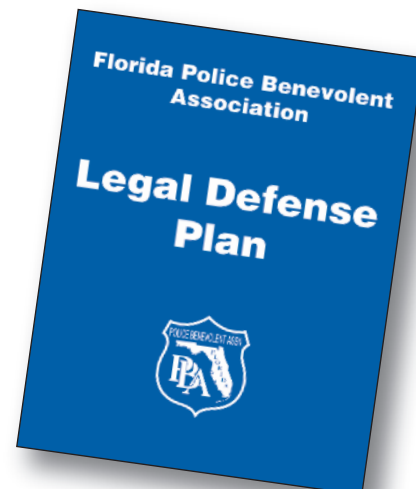
# What happens when you face legal action for simply doing your job?

## FOP's Legal Plan leaves you defenseless!

A "Committee" of FOP members will determine if your case is a "critical incident" and if you warrant representation. If not, you will be "notified that fees and/or coverage will not be provided."

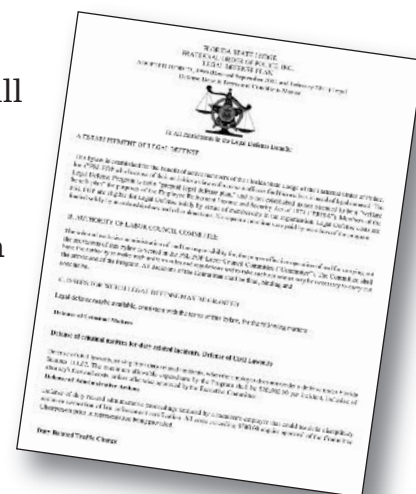

## You are stuck paying anything above this amount!

The "Committee" also decides when to settle your case or cease litigation. (Source: FOP Legal Defense Plan Defense Benefit Terms and Conditions Manual February 2011 Page 3, paragraph 9)
